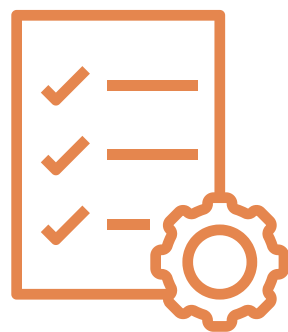


### Our Mission:
