

Pathways to Restorative Leadership

Restorative practices is a social science that studies how to build social capital and achieve social discipline through participatory learning and decision making. The use of Restorative practices helps to prevent bullying, improve human behavior, strengthen civil society, provide effective leadership, restore relationships, and resolve conflict and repair harm within schools, businesses and organizations. Restorative practices is a leadership model based on the premise that people will be happier, more productive and more willing to change behavior when people with authority over them do things WITH them as oppose to doing things TO them or FOR them or NEGLECTING them.

An intensive group experience, this session will immerse participants in a culture of restorative practices. The session will emphasize self-assessment of both personal and professional styles and growth in Restorative practices. Participants will also learn to facilitate and implement a professional learning group.
